Integrated Dual Disorder Treatment is an evidence based program. It is a collaborative effort with Case Western Reserve University, ODMH and ODADAS. The program is designed to improve the quality of life for individuals suffering from both mental health and substance abuse disorders. Recovery Services of Northwest Ohio offers this treatment program, making it possible to address both mental health and substance abuse issues at the same time and through the same organization.

IDDT decreases

- Duration, frequency and intensity of mental and substance use disorders
- Hospitalization
- · Arrest and incarceration
- Duplication of services
- Treatment discontinuation
- · Utilization of high-cost services

- IDDT increases
 - Abstinence from use of alcohol and other drugs
 - · Continuity of care
 - Improved relationships
 - · Quality of life
 - · Stable housing
 - Independent living
