

SITE HEALTH & SAFETY ORGANIZATION at RSNWO

Tobacco

It shall be the policy of RSNWO to provide a tobacco-controlled environment to consumers and visitors of the RSNWO. This policy utilizes the Harm Reduction Model as it relates to the use of tobacco products including smoked or smokeless tobacco on the premises by consumers or visitors of RSNWO in all locations operated by the organization. At each site location, there is a designated smoking area that is identifiable by smoking receptacles, but no smoking is permitted near entrances or exits of RSNWO.

Weapons

It is illegal to carry a firearm, deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance anywhere on RSNWO premises (including parking lot). Unless otherwise authorized by law, no person shall knowingly possess, have under the person's control, convey, or attempt to convey a deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance onto RSNWO premises (including parking lot). This is regardless of permit for concealed carry license.

Illegal or Legal Substances or Prescription Medication

If a Client is found to be intoxicated their state of intoxication will be assessed and transportation may be found to take the intoxicated person home or to a treatment center. The local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) will be called if the Client is experiencing a medical emergency. If an intoxicated Client insists on driving, the police will be notified. You may be asked to provide a drug screen to evaluate level of intoxication.

Illicit substances are prohibited from being brought into the facility. Should illicit substances be discovered, law enforcement will be contacted. Prescription medications must be secured on your person at all times and cannot be made accessible to others. Should RSNWO staff be made aware of this law enforcement will be contacted. Additionally RSNWO is not responsible or liable for any mishandling or negative reaction you may have to your medication. Medications including Suboxone and ReVia should not be brought on site unless specifically for MAT appointment.
